SATs, Revision Guides and Support Books

Dear Parents and Carers,

We firstly want to start by saying how wonderful it was to see so many of you at parents evening. The children have started their time in Year 6 so well and have adapted to the 'new normal' way of school life so effortlessly. They really are a credit to you all. We are really proud of them all and can't believe there are only a few weeks before the Christmas break starts on 18 December.

As some of you may be aware, we usually hold a Year 6 SATs meeting around this time to give some key information around the SATs process; how we support in school, as well as key dates and resources that can be used at home. Schools across the country are still unsure of the DFE's intentions around school assessments and schedules for this academic year, so currently we have no further information to share. When we do, we will of course schedule a meeting to feedback all the information and plans regarding SATs and secondary transition.

In the absence of further guidance from the DFE, we wanted to reassure you that this this isn't going to stop us here at ACE. We will be organising our annual booster club sessions within our Year 6 bubble, organising additional support groups in school, as well as additional home learning packs, that will start over the Christmas break. We also wanted to share with you some great additional revision resources, that we have available to purchase in school.

You may already be aware of the CGP revision guides; they are highly regarded and we have even used the materials in school too. After some negotiation, we have managed to get packs of 3 Year 6 revision and activity books at a discounted price that we would like to offer. The packs consist of one Grammar, Maths and Reading revision and activity books and are only available to Year 6. These retail around £5 per book, but we are offering the bundles at £10 for all three.

Revision Guide bundles can be ordered through Tucasi and will be delivered to your child at the end of the week you have ordered. We only have a small number of these, so they will be sold on a first come, first served basis and make a great stocking filler idea for your child. *They may or may not see it that way, but they are really good materials.*
