The film has a rating of PG with consent needed for us to show it.

We are planning on watching the film on Friday 12th of May. If we do not hear from you by **Thursday 11th May**, then we will assume that your child has permission to view the film.

If you wish for your child to be withdrawn then please send in a letter to your child's class teacher as soon as possible. Appropriate alternative work will be provided for these children so they do not miss out on any learning opportunities.
