Learning Focus:	Our learning focus for this workshop is on the following areas of the Early Years curriculum - Communication and Language: Children will learn new vocabulary, connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives and retell a familiar story. Understanding of the World: Children will compare and contrast characters from stories. Expressive Art and Design: Children will listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.

Other Information:	This half term we have been learning all about Traditional Tales within our theme of 'Once upon a time'. To summarise our learning, children will be taking part in an interactive storytelling workshop. It will focus on the retelling of the traditional tale 'The ugly duckling'.
