Our ACE Vision and Values

I am pleased to be able to share with you some work we have been doing to review the vision and values which are in place for our school.

Our school ethos is based around our Christian vision which remains the same as:

We will be focusing on a different value each half term and this will link to our daily collective worship. Children will be encouraged to learn a Bible verse and consider how the Biblical principles we are learning can impact upon their everyday lives.
