Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to let you know that school has again been given places for some of our children to run in the Mini London Marathon on Saturday 25th April 2026. This is a fantastic opportunity that will give pupils the chance to run either a 1 mile or 2.6km route around Buckingham Palace in Central London, finishing their run on the official finishing line of the TCS London Marathon.

Children completing the run will receive an official marathon medal. School will also receive £10 for each child who completes the race. We were lucky enough to take part in this event last year and the pupils who took part all had an amazing experience.

This opportunity is available to pupils from all year groups from Reception to Year 6. Pupils in YR – 3 will complete the 1 mile course and pupils in Y4-6 have the choice of completing the 1 mile or longer 2.6km route. We have been allocated a total of 40 places across both races with a different numbers of places being available for each race length and for each year group.

If you are registering your interest for more than one child, please complete the form separately for each child. Please note that we expect a lot of interest in these places. They will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, according to the allocation criteria of race length and age group. Please note that it will be the responsibility of parents and carers to get their children to the start line in Central London on Saturday 25th April by our allocated time and pick them up again from the finish line. Infant pupils will run in with an adult from the school. Junior pupils have the choice to run on their own or with an adult from school. We have not yet been given the start time for our school – this will be sent out to us by the start of April. More details will be given to those taking part closer to the time.
