Dear Parents and Carers,

Thursday 4th June is our Sports Day and we are thrilled to be able to welcome parent spectators to this event.

Our Junior events will be running from 9.00 until approximately 11.15am and will take place on the school field. The events will be made up of a carousel of activities, including sprints, obstacle races, throwing and many more. Each event will take place in the children's class groups. We ask that all children wear their house t-shirt to school on this day.

Parents who have children in both the infants and juniors are welcome to attend both parts of the day, but will need to leave the school site during lunch break and to give us the opportunity to set up for the Infant activities in the afternoon, with re-admission to the site when the gates re-open.

The gate will open at 1.45pm and Year 1 and 2 parents can again spectate from the assigned space on the school field. We ask that no more than 3 people from each family attend and all younger siblings must be supervised throughout the duration of sports day.

The spectator area will be marked off in the centre of the field; this enables you to move around and observe each of the activities running. All spectators need to remain in the allocated space throughout the duration of the events. You may wish to bring a foldable chair if you find standing for too long difficult, as seating will not be provided by school. However, this is not a necessity, as you may wish to move around the parents' viewing area to observe each activity.

School has a limited amount of toilet facilities available on the day and access to the school building will be restricted throughout the duration.

The school staff will be keeping scores throughout the event and the winning house will be announced during Celebration Worship at the end of the week. We are looking forward to a fun event, so please be a really generous and positive audience for all the children throughout the event.

Our lovely PTA group will be supplying light refreshments, which you can purchase during the morning and afternoon events.

Smoking, E-cigarettes and vapes are not permitted on the school grounds. Please also note that dogs and the consumption of alcoholic beverages are also not allowed within our school site.

Thank you for your understanding and we look forward to welcoming you on Thursday 4th June.
