Trustees Report 2020-21

Following a *second* Covid-19 Lockdown from December through to March this year, the PTA fundraising (yet again) has been somewhat restricted.

School remained open, and teaching and school staff continued to work tirelessly supporting those in school and those at home, however the PTA felt it was inappropriate to attempt any fundraising events, and had no choice but to respect Government guidelines and follow social distancing restrictions. We hope that everyone understands and respects this decision.

The key role of the PTA is to raise funds which enhance and support the education of the pupils at Ashford Church of England Primary School. The focus for fundraising over recent years has been to enhance the outdoor playgrounds by installing two trim trails. We are delighted that this project was finally completed on the children's return to school following the second lockdown.

We are currently seeking a new Treasurer. The role has very kindly been managed wonderfully by Mrs Wendy Pyke over the past 2 years, alongside her Business Manager role within school. We are therefore hopeful that someone will step forward to take over this vital role and allow Wendy to focus solely on her job within school.

Our highlights from September 2020 – September 2021 included:

Although a great deal of time and effort went into organising the event, it proved successful and gave us great links with the local community and businesses.

- June 2021 – The Father's Day Chocolate bars were a great idea and proved very popular with families saying how nice it was to receive a gift designed by their child/children.
- June 2021 - The Smartie tube fundraiser was an amazing idea and raised the most money from all our events so far this year!
