Science

This half term we are working scientifically by carrying out investigations to test our predictions. To fit in with our theme, Ticket To Ride, you are going to make paper aeroplanes and test which ones fly the furthest. First of all, think about which type of paper would make the aeroplane fly the furthest. The children need to look around the house and gather some different types of paper, this might be newspaper, baking paper, tissue paper, cardboard etc. when they have gathered it they need to look at the different types of paper and predict which one would make the best paper aeroplane and why, fill in the attached worksheet to explain their thoughts.

Now make a few paper aeroplanes from different types of paper. You can use the templates attached or design your own. You are then going to fly them and see which one goes the furthest. Then discuss the following questions;

- Which type of paper made the plane fly the furthest?
- Why do you think this was?
