**RE How Can The Example of a Saint Help a Christian With How To Live Their Life Today?**

Introduction:

The Church sets aside one day to celebrate all these important Christians which includes saints that do not have their own specific day on which they are celebrated.

Main:

A saint is a person who loves God and who loves others the way Christians believe God loves us.

Why are saints important to Christians?

Why do Christians celebrate All Saints Day? (1<sup>st</sup> Nov each year)

On this day the Christian Church recognises people who have been sanctified (made Holy) by the presence of God in their lives. It also celebrates the life of many ordinary men and women who also try to love God in the way Christians believe Christ loves us.

Activity:

Children to research the life of a particular saint. (Maybe St Matthew or St Hilda)
